



## HELL ARROW



An Elf or Dark Elf will gain +1 Combat for one turn.

## MIST KEY



A Halfling or Goblin will gain +1 Wit for one turn.

## MANNA ICE



A Mage or Witch will gain +1 Wit for one turn.

## BLADE RUNE



A Dwarf or Orc will gain +1 Combat for one turn.

## EAGLE BOOTS



An Adventurer with Eagle boots gains double movement for one turn.

## SEER SCROLL



An Adventurer with a Seer Scroll gains +1 Wit for one turn.

## SHATTER SCROLL



An Adventurer with a Shatter Scroll may automatically avoid a trap or open a door.

## MIGHT POTION



An Adventurer with a Might Potion gains +1 Combat for one turn.

## HEALING STONE



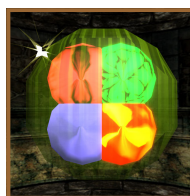
An adventurer with a healing stone may heal another player.

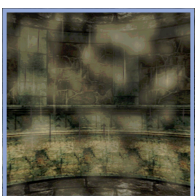

## EARTH QUAKE



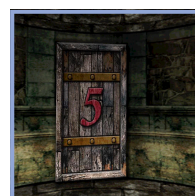
All movement is reduced to 1 space as players try to remain standing.

## DARKNESS



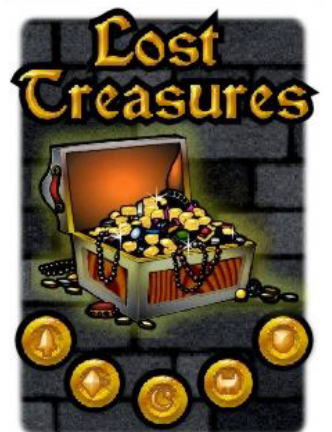
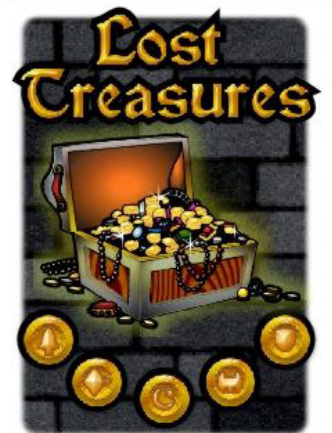
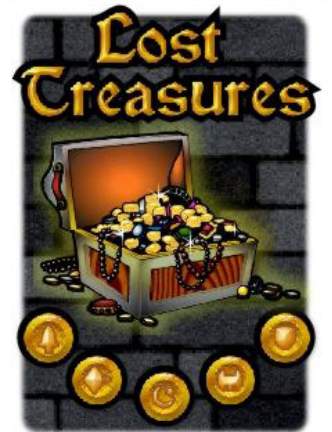
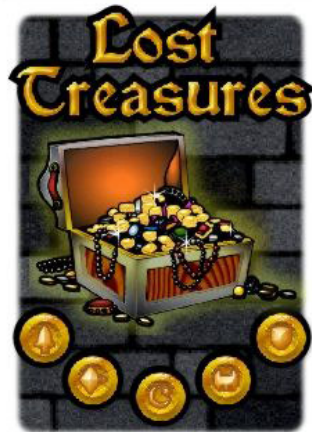
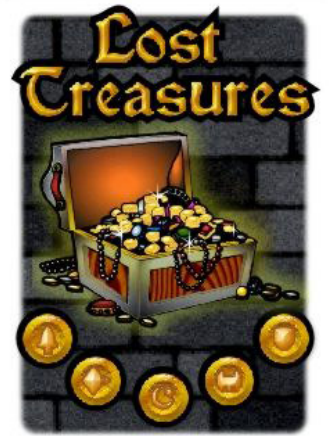
No combat can occur as a sudden wind blows out all the lanterns in the Dungeon.

## Printing This Document

Page one needs to be printed three times to give a total of 48 cards  
(12 of each profession)

Page two needs to be printed once to give 12 item cards and 4 event cards

Page three can be printed on the back of the previous pages (If using cardstock)

OR

Page three can be printed four times to be glued to the back of the other sheets

Page four is a guide to printing and does not need to be printed.

## Tips for Printing.

This Document has been created using A4 but can be aligned easily for Letter.

The option to use in your printer preferences is:

“Rotate and centre page”

This should allow you to print the document at 100% without needing to reduce the size of the image. (The images are designed for both page sizes).

An error may appear stating items are outside the printable area, but you should be able to ignore it.

In the event there is some clipping of the images, (due to physical limitations of the print device) then the following printer preferences may be used:

“Fit to Printer Margins”

“Reduce to Printer Margins”

These preferences will reduce the size of the images, But so long as they are used for all documents, should not effect the end result.
